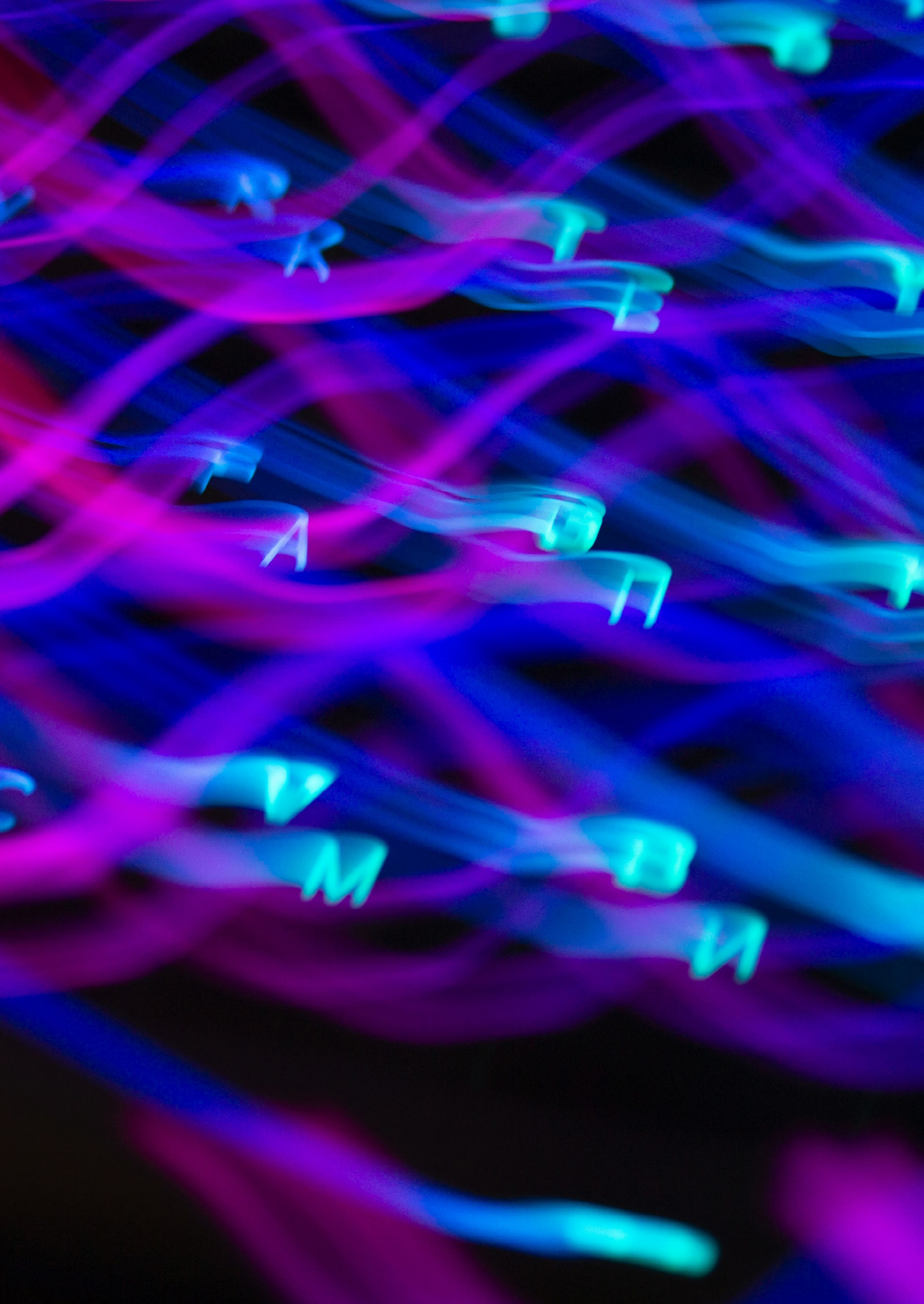

A unique resource for interdisciplinary research tackling the global social challenges

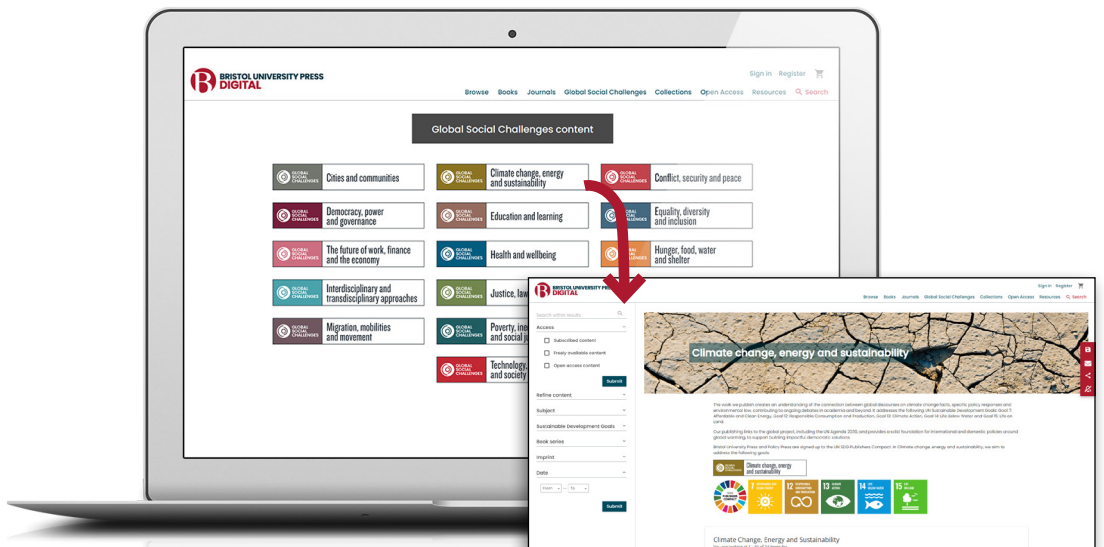
